













## Sharon Mountain Preserve Bog Bridge Trail

 Right turn

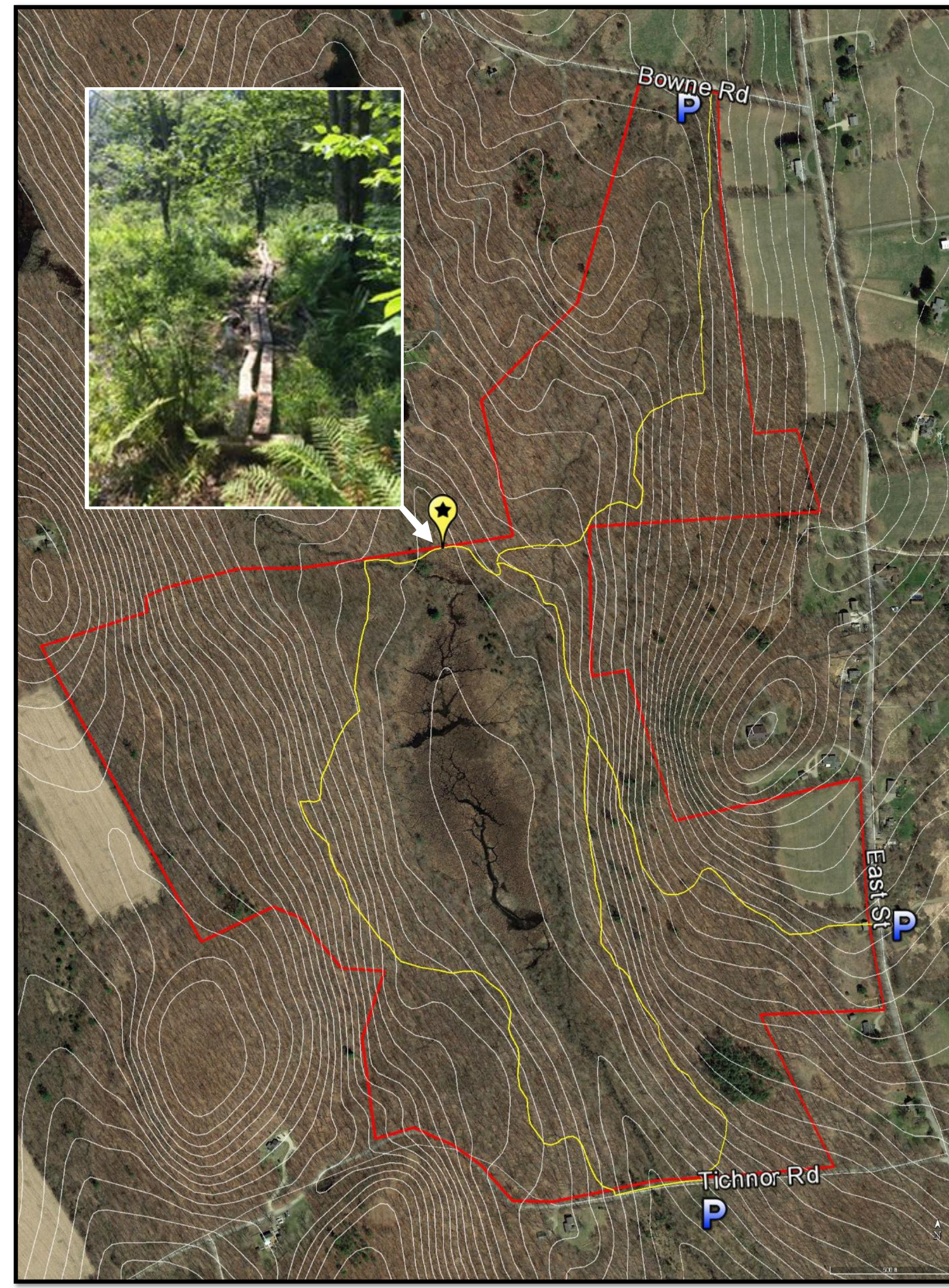
Trail Distances:

 East St Entrance - 0.3mi



 Dogs are permitted on a leash.

Nestled between two ridges, this secluded property contains a beautiful loop trail around a bog teeming with amazing flora and fauna. One featured attraction, a one hundred foot long bog bridge, was added in 2017 to connect the loop. Whether you enter from East St, Bowne Rd or Tichnor Rd, you will experience pristine rambling streams, a bog filled with ecological wonders, hardwood forest stands with beautiful wild grasses, rocky hills covered in mountain laurel, old charcoal pits and stone walls from hundreds of years ago.
